Publication terms

1. **Copyright and grant of license for initial publication:** The Author retains copyright to the Work. By signing this document, the Author grants non-exclusive permission to Dartmouth Library to distribute the work freely in any format now known or later developed and the right to license and permit others to do the same. This agreement does not prohibit the Author from publishing part or all of the work elsewhere.
2. **Warranties:**
 - a. Copyright to any ancillary materials used in this digital publication (including but not limited to visual materials, audio files, and extensive extracts of text) included in this work remains with the copyright holders of those works. The Author is expected to have copyright permissions for all external materials in the Work, including materials they may have published elsewhere. If they have not received such permissions, inclusion of any copyrighted material must be covered by fair use or other relevant exceptions.
 - b. The Author releases The Library and The Trustees of Dartmouth College from any responsibilities relating to any legal actions incurred by the contents of the Work.
3. **Delivery:** The Author agrees to deliver to the Library a complete and final manuscript of the Work in a format specified by the Library. The Library is not responsible for lost or damaged files and the Author is advised to retain a back-up copy of the final manuscript of the Work.
4. **Publication:**
 - a. The Library agrees to publish the Work upon receipt of a complete and acceptable manuscript of the Work, and to make and keep the Work available according to its customary standards.
 - b. The Work will be made available by open access under the terms selected above, free of charge. The Library will not employ access controls to limit the availability of the Work to certain persons or geographic locations unless requested by the Author.
 - c. The Library will provide DOIs and other metadata for the Work according to its customary standards as it deems necessary, using the Library's imprint.
5. **Royalty and usage statistics:**
 - a. The Library will not sell access to the Work and will not provide any royalties to the Author.
 - b. The Library will, on the basis of its customary standards, provide the Author with statistics demonstrating the numbers of accesses to the Work (called "usage statistics").
